




Figure 1: Number of confirmed COVID-19 cases by notification week and epidemiological week in Ireland between week 8, 2020 and week 4, 2021.

At the end of week 53 a significant number of cases were awaiting processing, as a result the number of cases reported in week 53 is reduced and the number of cases reported in week 1 is inflated.

In between week 15 and 16 (05/04/2020 – 19/04/2020) the daily number of COVID-19 events notified in Ireland is inflated due to batch reporting of cases with specimen dates between from 19/03/2020 – 01/04/2020 in addition to real-time reporting of cases with contemporaneous specimen dates




Figure 2: Number of confirmed COVID-19 cases by notification week and weekly incidence rate per 100,000 population in Ireland between week 10, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 3: Number of confirmed COVID-19 cases, and 7-day moving average, by notification date in Ireland between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 4a: Cumulative 14-day incidence rate of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population notified in Ireland by notification and epidemiological date* between week 8, 2020 and week 4, 2021.

*Epidemiological date: is based on the earliest of dates available on the case and taken from date of onset of symptoms, date of diagnosis, laboratory specimen collection date, laboratory received date, laboratory reported date or event creation date/notification date on CIDR. By using this date rather than event creation/notification date, adjusts for any delays in testing/notification. Please note that the trend in cases by epidemiological date will show a lag for recent days and therefore should be interpreted with caution.

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


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Figure 5a: Cumulative age- and sex-specific incidence




Cumulative age- and sex-specific rate per 100,000 population from week 48, 2020 to week 4, 2021




Figure 6a: Weekly age-specific incidence rates of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in Ireland between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 6b: Weekly age-specific incidence rates of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in Ireland between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 6c: Weekly age-specific incidence rates of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population in Ireland between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.


Figure 11: Weekly Incidence rates of confirmed COVID-19 cases per 100,000 population cases by Dublin Local Health Offices (LHOs) notified in Ireland between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 12a: Number of SARS-CoV-2 tests and positive tests* in Ireland between week 13, 2020 and week 4, 2021.


Figure 12b: Number of SARS-CoV-2 negative and positive tests* completed in Ireland between week 13, 2020 and week 4, 2021.

% SARS-CoV-2 positivity data from sentinel GP COVID-19 referrals tested by NVRL






Figure 13b: % SARS-CoV-2 positivity data from sentinel GP COVID-19 referrals tested by the NVRL by week specimen was taken, weeks 48 2020 to 4 2021. The Epidemiological week is Monday to Sunday (ISO week) in line with influenza/COVID-19 international reporting to ECDC.




Figure 14: Number of hospitalised COVID-19 cases based on ICU admission status in Ireland between week 10, 2020 and week 4, 2021*




Figure 15a: Daily and 7-day moving average number of deaths among COVID-19 cases notified in Ireland by date of death and cumulative total between week 10, 2020 and week 4, 2021.




Figure 15b: Daily and 7-day moving average number of deaths among COVID-19 cases notified in Ireland by date of death and cumulative total, between week 48, 2020 and week 4, 2021.

Technical Notes



1. Data Source

- Data are based on statutory notifications and were extracted from Computerised Infectious Disease Reporting (CIDR) system. Data are provisional and subject to ongoing review, validation and update. As a result, figures in this report may differ from previously published figures.
- Slides 23 and 24 include data reported from the Irish sentinel GP network.

2. Epidemiological date

 Epidemiological date is based on the earliest of dates available on the case and taken from date of onset of symptoms, date of diagnosis, laboratory specimen collection date, laboratory received date, laboratory reported date or event creation date/notification date on CIDR. By using this date rather than event creation/ notification date, adjusts for any delays in testing/notification.

3. Population data

Population data were taken from Census 2016. Data were aggregated into the following age groups for the analysis: 0-4 years, 5-12 years, 13-18 years, 19-24 years, 25-34 years, 35-44 years, 45-54 years, 55-64 years, 65-74 years, 75-84 years and ≥ 85 years.
