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## **Treatment outcome: 2015 cases**

Outcome was recorded for 183 (64.7%) of the 283 cases notified in 2015. Treatment outcome was not reported for the remaining 100 (35.3%) cases. Of the 10 deaths reported, one (0.4% of total cases) was attributed to TB.

Outcome was reported for 48 (64.0%) of the 75 sputum smear positive cases. Treatment outcome was unknown for the remaining 27 (36.0%) smear positive cases. Of the three deaths among smear positive cases, one was attributed to TB.

Of the 11 cases in 2015 with drug resistance other than MDR/XDR\* detected, four (36.4%) were reported as having completed treatment, one died and one case was lost to follow up. Treatment outcome was not reported for the remaining five (45.5%) resistant cases.




Figure 1: Number of TB notifications by treatment outcome and year




Figure 2: Percentage of TB notifications by treatment success and year

Table 1 gives details of treatment outcome for total cases and for sputum smear positive cases, while <u>Table 2</u> gives details of treatment outcome by HSE area for 2015. <u>Figure 1</u> illustrates the trend in treatment outcome between 2006 and 2015 while <u>figure 2</u> displays the percentage of TB notifications by treatment success and year for all cases, new pulmonary culture positive cases and for new sputum smear positive cases.

## Treatment outcome: 2014 MDR-TB and XDR-TB cases†

Of the three MDR-TB cases reported in 2014, one completed treatment, one case died and one case did not have treatment outcome reported at the time of report production. Treatment outcomes for the MDR-TB cases reported during 2015 are not yet available, due to the extended treatment period.




Figure 3: Number of MDR-TB notifications by treatment outcome and percentage treatment success by year

<u>Figure 3</u> shows the number of MDR-TB notifications by treatment outcome and percentage treatment success by year.
