ALERT FOR DRUG USERS

New HIV infections are increasing among people who inject drugs



HIV AND DRUG USE

- There is an increase in new HIV infections among people who inject drugs.
- Injecting any drug, including snowblow and other head shop drugs is high risk for viruses such as HIV and Hepatitis.
- Link with drug services in your area.

Get Tested!

The only way to know if you have HIV is to get tested.



UNSAFE INJECTING

- Always use clean & sterile equipment (needles, syringes, spoons, water, filters, etc.).
- Never share or re-use needles or equipment with another drug user, not even your partner.
- Get your own equipment from your local needle exchange.
- Always dispose of your needles and equipment safely.



SAFER SEX

The sexual transmission of HIV may be prevented by safer sex practices:

- Always use condoms correctly during sex.
- Remember to use a condom every time you have sex.
- Only use a condom once. Never ever reuse it!
- Condoms are available for free in all needle exchanges.
